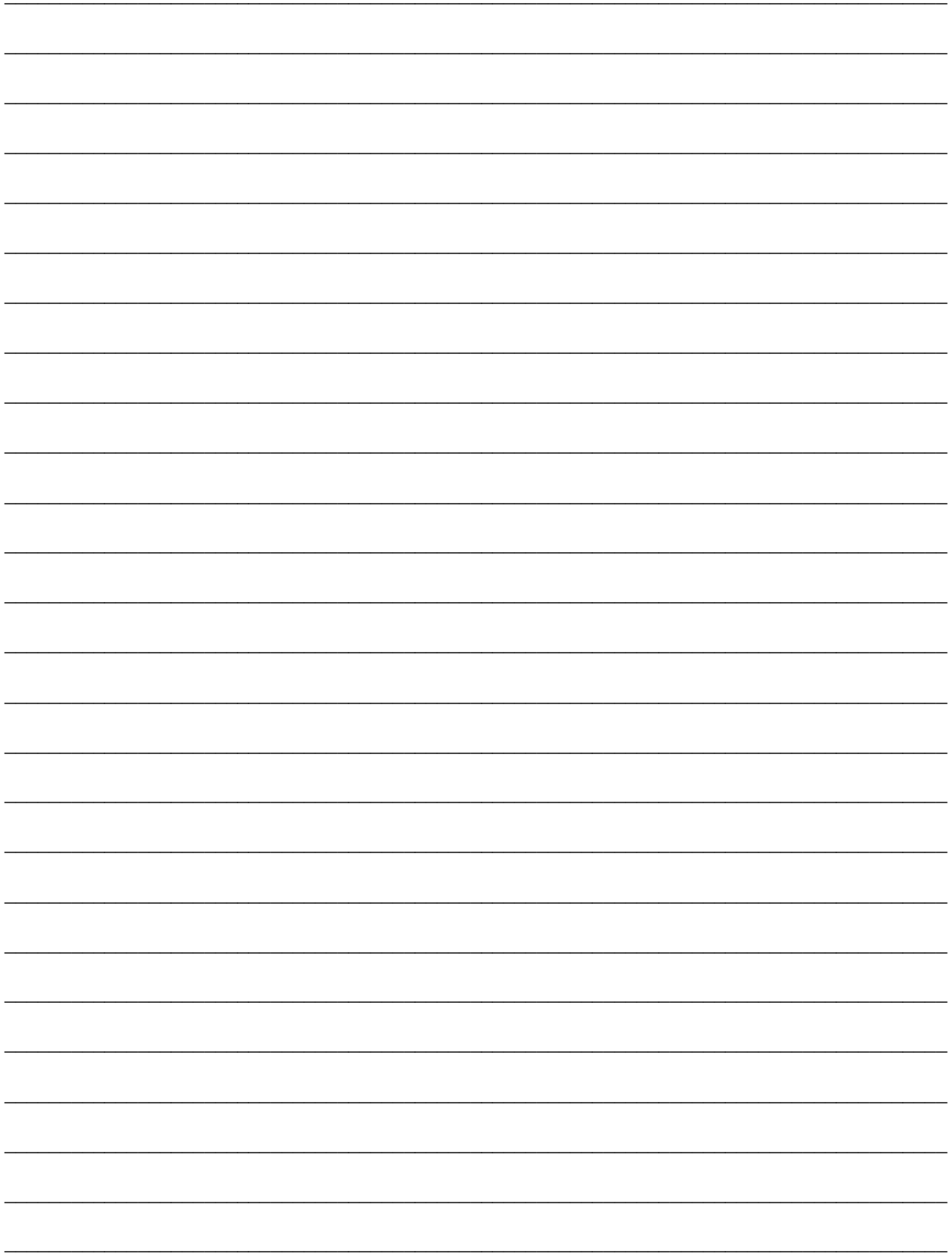

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

JUDGING CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged based on essay content and recommendation letters. Judges will determine how our services can best serve the needs of the applicants.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. To qualify for the chance to receive a FREE professional assessment and consultation package, you must be a legal resident of California under 18 years of age. You must also meet the income requirement for low-income families, as determined by U.S. federal law. Please see the following as a guideline:
 - Annual Income for 2-Person Household: \$21,709
 - Annual Income for 3-Person Household: \$27,312
 - Annual Income for 4-Person Household: \$32,914If selected, you will be required to show proof of income.
2. For all submissions, we require parent or legal guardian consent.
3. Applications must be submitted online or e-mailed between the 1st and the 15th day of each month between July 2015 to December 2015, no later than 11:59 PM (Pacific Standard Time). Your application must include the General Form, the 50-200 word essay question, proof of income requirement (e.g. copy of Medi-Cal card, W2 form, or SSI letter), and a reference from a teacher or church leader. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
4. Recipients of PPEOP will be notified before last day of each month to arrange an appointment for the assessment and consultation service, which will take place within three months following the month of submission. If the recipient fails to respond or to arrive at their scheduled meeting, we reserve the right to cancel or withhold the benefits from the recipient of PPEOP.
5. Entry is only valid for consideration in the immediate month.
6. Re-entries are permitted. There is no limit to the number of times an applicant may re-enter. All rules pertaining to the submission still apply.
7. The essay must be solely the original work of the entrant based on their true situations and stories.
8. Presence Possibilities reserves the right to change the terms and service from time to time and to provide extensions for contest deadlines and awarded service when deemed appropriate.
9. Decisions made by the judges are final.
10. If selected, you will need to be able to come in to our headquarters in City of Industry, CA for the initial assessment. Travel expenses will not be covered.
11. Presence's employees, board of directors, and their immediate family and relatives are not eligible to participate. Past recipients of PPEOP are not eligible to participate.
12. Recipients of PPEOP are responsible for providing their mailing addresses and other necessary information under the law in order to receive the awarded service package.
